# <u>Earls Colne Baptist Church Health and Safety Policy and Risk Assessment</u> (Updated March 2024)

Health and safety measures associated with the church building are the responsibility of the minister and deacons (legally the trustees of the organisation).<sup>1</sup>

The church building is currently closed for general use, as urgent repairs are needed, but the church does not have sufficient funds to carry them out. The building should only be entered for the briefest time possible to check on its condition or to access or return items.

Church members and attendees are now meeting in the manse (downstairs only) for worship, study and meetings. The church's toddler group are meeting at Earls Colne Recreational Club.

Any accidents should be recorded on accident forms (kept in a labelled cupboard in the church kitchen and in the manse office) and stored responsibly by the church. Any broken or dangerous items should be fixed or replaced as soon as possible.

Please see below for the church's risk assessment for all areas of the church building, car park and garden, the downstairs of the manse, ECBC's cemetery ground and for the church's toddler group.
